

Brief Review (2007 year) of Konstantin & Lina Zhigulin.

1. **Composing work.**

In the beginning of 2007 year I continue work with Mark Shipp (professor of the Old Testament in Austin Graduate School of Theology) for translation of my songs in English. We made translated a few more songs and prepare songbook in English for print process.

In June, 2007 I spent time for preparation of my class in Russian Annual Singing Schools. In August, 2007 I start working with Mark Shipp for his project of metrical Psalter/hymnal. I've composed music for psalm 6 ("Return, o Lord") & start to work at psalm 17. Also we translated my song "In the day of Distress" (psalm 20). In the end of August I composed song "With what shall I come to the Lord" (Micah6:6-8), specially for ACU lectureship.

2. **"Psalom" - Konstantin Zhigulin`s Spiritual Music Ensemble.**

In May, 2007 we take part in Annual Siberian Christian Seminar in Barnaul. In the end of April ensemble start second US trip. We sing in more than 20 places (churches, universities). During this trip we found the time for a few recording sessions in ACU. Result of that is new album with title "Peace to you". In the end of the trip we take part in "Ascending Voice Symposium" of church Acapella music in Papperdine University. After our traveling to the US in May & June we made two month break to work in church field. In August we were back to rehearsals. We had been invited to lead worship at the ACU Lectureship on Sun. Sept. 16. During our trip in September, 2007 we made a presentation of new songs for Church of Christ in the US (more then 20 presentations) & few presentation in EEM dinners.



3. **Teaching.**

In July we taught new Christian songs in my class on Russian annual Singing School. June & August were dedicated to ministry of leading singing in the church. In August I started teaching a class for song leaders & worship leaders in our congregation.

In October and November – I lead a course "Liturgical life of the church" for students who wanted to become song leaders & worship leaders in future service in church.

Lina taught music notation & conducted a class in Russian Annual Singing School. In July & August she help in the work of the church choir and worked as a secretary in our congregation "Church of Christ on Neva", S-Petersburg. Lina helped me in work for all of my projects and helped the church choir. Her work in the church, in the ensemble, in the chore, in the institute is big part of our life.
