In May of 2015 year I lead worship and singing class in *May-Conference for Russian churches* and few times visit church in Tallinn (Estonia) for help with worship there.

June is time of preparation for *Annual Christian Singing School*. In the end of June we had singing classes in *Baltic Christian Youth Camp* (Estonia).

In July we (me and my wife) were directing and teaching at the *Annual Christian Singing School* in St. Petersburg. We got 28 students and 5 teachers. People from about 10 cities of Russia come to be part of it. It was a real inspiration event.



In September I lead singing and teach about worship in seminar *Prayer with love* in Kiev (Ukraine).

In October I visited a few churches in US who support our ministry for ministry-report and spiritual support. Also together with Wiley Dean we worked for recording of new songs with members of churches in Alabama. As well I've got an invitation from *Bellevue church of Christ* in South Nashville for lead their singing classes, so, I visited them and it was great meeting.



In November we made first trip of *Psalom* for start our ministry in Europe. We visited congregations in Germany and Holland. Also we participated in *Euro-American Family retreat* and got connected with brothers and sisters from Poland, Yugoslavia, Croatia, Austria, Belgium and France. It is great joy to see how church, like in the ancient times, chooses the path of reconciliation, forgiveness and Christ's love. To have our ensemble, which consists both of Russians and Americans, present during such times of confrontation is in itself a proclamation of peace and understanding!
